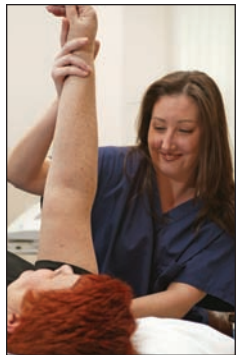
Quality of Care
